



Our Vaccination Policies

Required Vaccinations

To help ensure the health and safety of all of our canine clients, we maintain the vaccine requirements detailed below. Please feel free to ask if you have any questions or have your veterinarian call us directly.

Rabies

Every Three (3) Years

All dogs must be vaccinated against rabies in order to attend Every Dog Has Its Day Care™, Inc. For dogs under one (1) year of age, the vaccine expires one (1) year from the date it was administered. For dogs over one (1) year of age the vaccine expires three (3) years from the date it was administered.

Distemper - Parvo Combination Vaccine

Every Three (3) Years

Different veterinarians choose different combinations for this important vaccine. We do not require a specific combination, however all dogs must be vaccinated against distemper, parvovirus and hepatitis (canine adenovirus-1) to attend daycare at Every Dog. Regardless of when the vaccine process was begun, all dogs must receive at least two (2) distemper-parvo combination vaccines with the last vaccine administered at 16 weeks of age or later. After the initial series of vaccines, we require that all dogs receive a distemper-parvo combination vaccine one (1) year after the first series and then every three (3) years thereafter.

Kennel Cough (*bordetella*)

Annual

To prevent the spread of this contagious disease, we require that all dogs that attend our facility receive a kennel cough vaccine annually. We recommend an intra-nasal vaccine that protects against *Bordetella bronchiseptica*, canine adenovirus-2 and parainfluenza, but any kennel cough vaccine will be accepted.

Leptospirosis

Annual

While we do not require this vaccine for eligibility, due to the severity of the disease, we highly recommend vaccinating your dog every year. It should be given to all dogs that are taken off-leash on trails and/or near any kinds of open water.

We must have written documentation from your veterinarian for all the vaccines we require.
